### **Background:**

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The Regulatory Affairs function within Gas Networks Ireland is responsible for the delivery of Market Operations, Market Development, implementation of EU Energy Market Regulations and Directives, as well as the strategy to deal with ongoing Regulatory compliance.

The Wholesale Market function is responsible for the delivery of Market Development (ROI and NI), EU Energy Market Directives.

Reporting to the Wholesale Market Manager, this position will involve the development of technical/operational and commercial arrangements in accordance with the relevant regulatory obligations, contractual framework and appropriate gas industry standards.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

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- Participation in the development of transportation arrangements arising from modifications to the Contractual and Legislative Framework.
- Analysis and development of specified processes to ensure effective and efficient operation in a multi-Shipper environment;
- Recommending changes and improvements of a technical and operational nature to the business process when inadequacies are found;
- Costing the various alternatives as recommended and determination of the optimum solution;
- Development of new processes and procedures associated with new Transportation Products;
- Development of appropriate Business Principles and Rules to address new development requirements including the introduction of the European Network Codes.
- Keeping up to date with all relevant regulatory obligations and appropriate gas industry standards;
- Development of project budgets and programmes
- Other duties as maybe assigned from time to time
