The Role:

Reporting to a Project Manager the main purpose of the role is to support the project management team in managing to successful conclusion all projects to which assigned from initial concept to the point of handing over of the constructed project as a fully operational entity to the Operations function.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Supporting the Project Manager and wider project team to ensure key milestones and project deliverables are met on time and on budget
- Supporting the tendering/procurement processes for projects in line with Ervia policy and ensuring commercial objectives of Ervia are achieved
- In conjunction with the Project Manager ensure that all site activities and construction works are carried out to the highest standards of safety and in accordance with all relevant legislation
- Suitably plan, organise, monitor and report on all phases of projects life cycle utilising PMO methodologies, processes and systems.
- Manage production and approval of project delivery plans, cash flow projections and earned value analysis.
- Review reports and submissions made by project consultants and provide comments to the consultants.
- Attend meetings with Consultants, Contractors and prepare records of these meetings.
- Contribute to the preparation of internal and external project reports.
- Provide construction monitoring support to resident engineering staff.
- Contribute to project close-out activities.
- Provide support to the Project Manager and other departments as required.
- Contribute to achieving the objectives and targets of the Major Projects Function and overall Ervia Business.
- Liaise with external stakeholders and represent the company in a professional and competent manner

- Liaise with internal Ervia stakeholders as required and ensure all corporate policies are fully adhered to
- Responsibility for day to day activities on Projects
- Performing other duties as assigned from time to time

Knowledge, Skills and Experience:

- Third level Degree in Engineering is required
